
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Our Organization

KUSHT NIYANTRAN EVUM UNMOOLAN SAMITI (KNEUS) is a registered voluntary organization working to help people suffering from leprosy, HIV/AIDS, TB, and other communicable diseases in the states of U.P., Uttarakhand and Delhi for more than two decades. In the year 1987 KNEUS started working in 57 leprosy colonies in the western U.P. and treated over 5000 leprosy patients. In 1992 this work was extended to villages and cities, where through house to house surveys and health education programmes patients were detected and treated. The leprosy focussed services carried out by the organization have been extended to TB after integration of leprosy treatment into general health in 2003. The systematic and scientific approach planned and implemented by KNEUS has yielded desired results over the years.

Objective

To collaborate and work towards the achievement of the national aim of controlling and eliminating leprosy, Tuberculosis and other communicable diseases.

Our Activities

1. LEPROSY

SET Project under NLEP

KNEUS takes pride in saying that its committed workers till now have detected 42054 leprosy patients of whom 37403 have completed treatment and are cured till March 2014. Our interventions have



helped them to lead a life of dignity and self respect. Our leprosy mission will continue until such time that the once dreaded disease is totally eradicated and the handicaps due to leprosy are totally taken care of.

Our present activity include doing IEC (Information, Education and Communication) in tune with the government guidelines of SET (Survey Education and treatment) modified (2004) and DPMR (Disability Prevention and Medical Rehabilitation) activities as per government guidelines.



2. TUBERCULOSIS

Designated Microscopy cum Treatment Centre Under RNTCP

Tuberculosis (TB) is a major public health problem in India. India accounts for one-fifth of the global TB incident cases. Each year nearly two million people in India contract



Tb of which around 0.87 million are infectious cases. It is estimated that around 3,30,000 Indians die due to TB.

Since 1993, the government of India has been implementing the WHO-

recommended DOTS strategy via the Revised National Tuberculosis Control programme (RNTCP). We have partnered with RNTCP for implementing DOTS at district & state levels.

Our approach focuses on the diagnosis, registration of the patient and medical supply (DOTS) in the poorest and most remote areas of U.P. and Uttarakhand.

3. HIV / AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAM

TB and HIV are heavily intertwined, each increasing the morbidity of the other. In India there are over five million HIV positive individuals. KNEUS have three DMC s in the NCR (Bhangel, Noida Sector 10 and Khora



village of Ghaziabad district). All the patients coming to the DMC s undergo ICTC test and positive cases are cared by being put into medication free of cost.



4. REHABILITATION PROGRAM

SAANJH NIVAS

Saanjh Nivas is a place to help the old and destitute. This is a project under construction. The aim of this programme is to provide shelter and medical aid to those deserted by their own kith and kin with love and respect. Under this programme the old and destitute will be looked after free of cost at Saanjh Nivas.

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
